## Dauphin County Court of Common Pleas seeks Official Court Reporter Harrisburg, Pennsylvania

The Dauphin County Court Reporters' Office is currently accepting applications for a full-time court reporter. This is a union position. Preference will be given to those applicants who have attained their CRR certification. Minimum qualifications are either an RPR Certification from the National Court Reporters Association OR two (2) years of court reporting experience (per RJA 5000.3) and be able to pass with 95% accuracy on the following: Literary at 180 wpm, Jury Charge at 200 wpm, and Testimony at 225 wpm.

The starting wage is \$50,772.80, plus transcript fees. Credentialed reporters receive an additional hourly rate. The successful candidate receives a generous benefits package including term life insurance, medical, dental and vision insurances. Vacation, sick, and personal leave; military leave; bereavement leave; nine paid holidays per year; pension plan; deferred compensation plan all begin to accrue immediately. All equipment, software support contracts, continuing education units and membership dues to both NCRA and PCRA are also provided.
